ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

I, the undersigned incorporator, hereby associate to form and establish a corporation NOT for profit under the laws of the State of Kansas.

- <u>FIRST:</u> The name of the corporation is KANSAS SECTION, SOCIETY FOR RANGE MANAGEMENT.
- SECOND: The location of the corporation in this state is Healy, Kansas.
- THIRD: The location of its registered office in this state is Healy, Lane County, Kansas.
- <u>FOURTH:</u> The name and address of its resident agent in this state is Art Armbrust, Healy, Lane County, Kansas.
- <u>FIFTH:</u> This corporation is organized exclusively for educational and scientific purposes for the study, management and uses of rangeland and range resources.
- <u>SIXTH:</u> The corporation shall NOT have authority to issue capital stock.
- <u>SEVENTH:</u> The conditions of membership in the corporation shall be stated in the by-laws of the corporation, but in no instance shall membership be denied because of race, religion, age, or sex of the applicant.
