Policy on Committee Appointments

Purpose: To provide a consistent policy on appointed committees, the following guidelines shall be followed: (See Bylaws: Article IV, Section 7)

1. The President, upon entering office, shall appoint a chairperson from the retiring committee members to coordinate and guide the committees.
2. Committee appointments shall be made by the following officers with consent of the Board of Directors:

| <u>length of term</u> | <u>by (upon assuming office)</u> |
|-----------------------|----------------------------------|
| Chairperson | President |
| 1 year First | Vice-President |
| 2 years | Second Vice-President |

3. All appointees shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing officer or their replacement with the consent of the Board of Directors.

Appropriate Bylaws Sections:

ARTICLE IV. Management of the Kansas Section

SECTION 7. The President shall have general supervision of the administration of the Section. He shall appoint members of the Section to fill vacancies in standing committees including chairpersonship, and may create and appoint chairpersons and members of ad hoc committees. He shall preside at meetings of the Board of Directors and of the Section.
