Guidelines for the

Student Affairs Committee

Purpose: The purpose of the student affairs committee is to initiate and sustain viable programs to generate and maintain interest among Kansas Section student members and other students (college and high school) in range management.

Structure: The committee shall consist of a chairperson, appointed by the President, and shall include one student club advisor, a student from each university and the chairperson of the Kansas Range Youth Camp.

Responsibilities:

1. Coordinate Range Youth Camp and encourage participation in the SRM High School Youth Forum.
2. Encourage and support participation in the University Student Conclave (Range Plant Judging Contest, Student Paper Session, Undergraduate Range Management Exam, Business Meetings.).
3. Encourage and support secondary school participation for range related activities (e.g. Range Judging Contests for 4-H and FFA).
4. Initiate new programs for students as the need and opportunity arises:
 - a. stimulate range educational activities.
 - b. promote utilization of available resources (including people) of the Section in increasing the knowledge and understanding of range management..
5. Give a written report of the committee's activities and proposals to the Board of Directors at the Section annual meeting.

Meetings: The student affairs committee shall meet once a year at the annual meeting of the Section.
